

Apprenticeship Bond of Alexander Boon, 1803

This bond is mostly typed with information such as names and dates written by hand. I have put the handwritten text in italic format to make it more clear which parts were handwritten. In this document, all “s” were written to look like “f” except for the very first “s” in “State of North Carolina”. Source citation is at the end of the transcript.

This Indenture, mad the *fourteenth*
Day of *Novr.* In the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight Hundred
and *Three* Between Timothy Hunter Chairman of
the County Court of *Bertie* County, and State aforesaid, on Behalf of the
Justices of the said County and their Successors, of the one Part and
Jesse Bazemore – of the other Part, WITNESSETH,
That the said *Timothy Hunter* in Pursuance to an Order
of said County Court, made the *14th* day of *Nov* and according
to the Directions of the Act of Assembly in that Case made and provided, doth put,
place and bind unto the said *Jesse Bazemore* – an Orphan [in margin: of colour]
named *Alexander Boon* now of the Age of *Seven*
Years, with the said *Jesse Bazemore* – to live after the
Manner of an Apprentice and Servant, until the said Apprentice his Master
faithfully shall serve, his lawful Commands every where readily obey: *he* shall
not at any Time absent *himself* from *his* said Master’s Service, but in all
Things as a good and faithful Servant shall behave towards *his* said Master
And the said *Jesse Bazemore* – doth covenant,
promise and agree to and with the said *Timothy Hunter*
that he will teach and instruct, or cause to be taught and instructed, the said
Alexander Boon – to learn *the art and mystery of a*
Cooper and that he will constantly find and provide for
said Apprentice, during the Term aforesaid, sufficient Diet, Washing, Lodging
and Apparel, fitting for an Apprentice; and also all other Things necessary, both in
Sickness and in Health.
